BUNCOMBE COUNTY SCHOOLS: A SNAPSHOT

- 13th largest school system (out of 115) in North Carolina based on student enrollment.
- Buncombe County Schools has approximately 24,700 students and 3,700 employees.
- Our school system ranks as the second largest employer in Buncombe County.
- Buncombe County Schools consists of 43 schools: 23 Elementary, 4 Intermediate, 7
 Middle, 6 Regular High Schools, 1 Alternative High School, 1 Early College and a Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) High School.
- Our school system is also home to a Progressive Education Program for students with special needs.
- More than 52% of Buncombe County Schools students receive free or reduced price lunch.
- Over 50 languages are spoken in homes of Buncombe County Schools Students.

CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT CRITERIA

(Highest to Lowest per Board Policy #9030 Facility Construction)

- 1. Facilities which contain progressively deteriorating conditions which, if not corrected, could prevent future use of the structure or result in **safety concerns**.
- 2. Facilities which do not provide for accessibility for all students and staff including those with disabilities.
- 3. Immediate facility needs created by the loss of leased/rental space or **catastrophic event** requiring replacement or relocation of an existing facility.
- 4. Facilities which are overcrowded to the extent that regular classrooms or basic courses must be housed in single/double-wide trailers or other comparable substandard space which negatively affect the instructional program (if the option of floating teachers has been utilized at middle or secondary schools).
- 5. Facilities in which necessary specialized **areas are lacking or extremely inadequate** to accommodate the educational program supported and funded by the Board of Education and/or the County Commissioners.
- 6. Pupil population membership and projections clearly indicate that a school population is consistently overcapacity, has been **overcapacity** for several years or will be overcapacity in the near future and is reasonably expected to continue to be overcapacity, necessitating construction of new facilities for regular classrooms, support areas or Board funded programs in order to **equitably meet the educational requirements** or needs of the student population.

CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT CRITERIA continued

- 7. Older facilities that require excessive maintenance or operational cost for continued operation and/or are unable to accommodate current educational requirements.
- 8. Facilities which lack the space necessary to implement the countywide grade organizational pattern.
- 9. Permanent facilities which lack adequate space to house non-basic classes or support services to the extent that they are housed in single/double-wide trailers or other comparable substandard space.
- 10. Facilities where it is recognized that maximum enrollment for the facility and/or site has been exceeded, resulting in possible problems related to health, safety, or educational program delivery.
- 11. Athletic facilities. Note that facilities regularly utilized for scheduled physical educational shall be considered a component of the basic course of study and are higher priority. Athletic facilities, funded by the Board of Educational or by community groups such as booster clubs, PTO etc., and accepted by the Board shall be maintained according to reasonable safety, accessibility, sanitary, building code and structural standards that apply to other Board assets.


NORTH BUNCOMBE ELEM. ADDITIONS & RENOVATIONS

NORTH BUNCOMBE MIDDLE ADDITIONS & RENOVATIONS



Subject: Modular Classroom Locations

I have completed a physical survey of location of modular classroom units during the month of April 2016. This report updates unit locations, any new units purchased by the BOE and relocations of units occurring this year. This survey is presented by school/location. For the purpose of this report, the following abbreviations will be used: single wide (SW), doublewide one classroom (DW), double-doublewide two classroom (DDW), modular/4 rooms (M/4R). (VAT) indicates the presence of vinyl asbestos floor tile and (C1) denotes state designated Chapter I units.

A DW modular unit from T.C. Roberson has been removed due to fire damage in 2015. These units have been removed from BOE inventory. We currently have (91) modular units in use providing (113) functional classroom spaces.
