Double Homicide Investigation

On Sunday March 15, 2015 the Buncombe County Sheriff's Office received a request for a welfare check at 87 Hookers Gap Road in the Leicester Community. Family members of JT and Christie Schoen-Codd had not heard from them and were concerned about their welfare. Patrol officers responded to the residence and ultimately met with a neighbor who had a key and were able to enter the residence and determine that there was evidence of suspicious activity. Patrol officers contacted the detective division and detectives responded. Detectives attempted to obtain contact information for friends and relatives and make some determination if the Codds could be located safely. When detectives were unable to locate the Codds a missing person investigation was started immediately. Detectives prepared and executed several search warrants and preservation orders for cellular telephone data. Detectives processed the residence throughout the evening and into the following morning. On Sunday evening the sheriff's office received a report of suspicious activity on Donna Drive in the Candler community. Deputies responded and recovered items belonging to Christie Schoen-Codd. Detectives were able to identify Robert Jason Owens and interviewed him in the early morning hours of Monday March 16, 2015. On Monday March 16, 2015 detectives contacted the Leicester Fire Department and a ground search was organized for the property at 87 Hookers Gap Road. The ground search was concluded the afternoon of Monday March 16, 2015 with nothing found. Detectives were able to obtain arrest warrants for Robert Jason Owens on Monday March 16, 2015 for the breaking or entering and larceny from 87 Hookers Gap Road. Robert Jason Owens was located and taken into custody that afternoon and interviewed by detectives. Information from that interview led detectives to prepare and execute several search warrants where material believed to be human remains was recovered from Owens residence at 8 Owens Cove Rd. in the Leicester community. To date detectives have prepared and executed multiple search warrants, conducted dozens of interviews and seized numerous items of evidence. The human remains have been delivered to Wake Forest Baptist Medical Center for analysis. Robert Jason Owens has been charged with two counts of First Degree Murder in the death of JT Codd, Christie Schoen-Codd and Murder of their unborn child. The investigation continues and detectives are actively gathering information in relation to the investigation.

This investigation was initiated on March 15, 2015 at 15:23 PM by a call to Buncombe County Sheriff's Office. The caller, Bill Schoen requested a welfare check for his daughter Cristie Codd who lived at 87 Hookers Gap Road, Leicester, NC. Bill Schoen advised that his daughter was to arrive in Mississippi around 4:00pm on 3/15/15. Bill Schoen advised that he has not had contact with his daughter and that is not normal for him not to have contact with his daughter. Schoen advised that his wife did speak with Cristie Codd on 3/14/15.

Buncombe County Sheriff's Deputies responded to the residence. Deputies obtained a key from a neighbor and gained access to the residence after failing to get a response at the residence. Deputies conducted a protective sweep of the residence and did not locate anyone at the residence. Deputies did observed Cristie Codd's purse and a wallet for her husband Joseph Codd inside the residence. Deputies did observe a medicine cabinet open inside the residence with band aids removed. Deputies located dogs inside the residence that had been unattended. The residence was secured by Deputies. Deputies located three vehicles at the residence; a 2008 Dodge truck, a 2005 Mercury Marquis and a 2011 Honda Element.

With the information provided by the affiant and the officers involved in this investigation a request is respectfully submitted to the court to allow the issuance of a search warrant authorizing the affiant and the officers involved in this investigation to search the residence, curtilage and vehicles located at 87 Hookers Gap Road, Leicester, NC 28748 and seized items listed in this affidavit.

Your affiant swears to the following facts to establish probable cause for the issuance of a search warrant:

Your affiant, Benjamin A. McKay, is a sworn law enforcement officer with the Buncombe County Sheriff's Office. Your affiant is currently assigned to the Buncombe County Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigations Division Special Investigation Unit and tasked with investigating elder and child abuse, sexual assault, domestic violence and internet crimes against children. Prior to your affiant's current assignment, your affiant was assigned to the Major Crimes Unit from September 10, 2012 to March 1, 2015. Prior to your affiant's employment with the Buncombe County Sheriff's Office, your affiant was a sworn law enforcement officer with Henderson County Sheriff's Office from May 20, 1989 to March 7, 2012. Your affiant's assignments at the Henderson County Sheriff's Office included Detention Officer, Patrol Officer, DARE Officer, School Resource Officer, Community Relations Lieutenant, Violent Crimes Investigations Supervisor, Animal Enforcement Lieutenant and Lieutenant of Criminal Investigations. Your affiant has received over 3000 hours of specialized law enforcement training and is a graduate of the 242nd Session of the FBI National Academy in Quantico, Virginia. Of these hours over 1000 hours specifically involve training in arrest, search and seizure, crime scene processing and investigation, death investigation courses and Law Enforcement Management training. Detectives also learned through an interview of Robert Jason Owens' wife Samantha Owens that he had told her that he was driving the 2008 Dodge Ram that belonged to the victim when he struck and killed the male victim at 87 Hookers Gap Road. Detectives seized the Dodge Ram and transported it to the secure lot at the Sheriff's Office in Leicester Crossing on New Leicester Highway.

With the information provided by the affiant and the officers involved in this investigation a request is respectfully submitted to the court to allow the issuance of a search warrant authorizing your affiant and the officers involved in this investigation to search the Grey in color 2008 Dodge Ram Pickup bearing NC CBJ-3332 and seize those items listed in this affidavit.
