## TV/PAINT RECYCLING EVENTS

Buncombe County Landfill also accepts the following items from residents\* **ONLY** during TV/Paint Recycling events. Check our website for event details and dates.



**Electronics:** Cell phones, keyboards, etc.



**Televisions, computer monitors and CPUs:** Everyday drop-off is available for residents who are able to self-unload.



**Paint:** Paint, paint thinners, water sealer, enamels, etc. 20-gallon limit per event.



**Flammable liquids:** Gasoline and kerosene.



**Pesticides:** Insecticides, herbicides, fungicides, etc.



**Unbroken fluorescent bulbs:** 20 bulbs max per month. Check online for bulb disposal quidelines.

**NOTE:** Bio-Hazardous materials, radioactive materials and explosives are **NOT** accepted.

\*Businesses can recycle electronics by the pound for a fee. No business hazardous wastes will be accepted.

### **ACCEPTED EVERYDAY**

The landfill also accepts the following materials everyday at the Convenience Center from residents only - no commercial quantities.

- Used cooking oil
- Motor oil
- Lead acid batteries
- Automotive fluids, oil filters and anti-freeze
